

The Way is a title given by Jesus Christ to Himself (John 14.6) and is the earliest name His followers gave to their beliefs and practices (Acts 24.14).

The Chi-Rho (above) within a circle signifying eternity is a very early monogram for Christ, the superimposed Greek letters X and P forming the first letters of His name. They form a cross, the upright P standing for His crucified body, and in our version (taken from a coin of an early Christian Roman Emperor) the arms of the X are nails, whose points meet at the centre.


